The First Cause is uncaused!
The First Cause had no beginning!


The Argument from Motion

- An infinite regress of things changed by already existing external influence is impossible.


The Argument from Motion







An Essential of the Faith: The Trinity

Law of Non-Contradiction:

Two opposite statements

can not be both true

at the same time

and in the same sense.

Make Distinction:

Trinity is NOT a contradiction!
