WHAT IS T.E.A.M.?

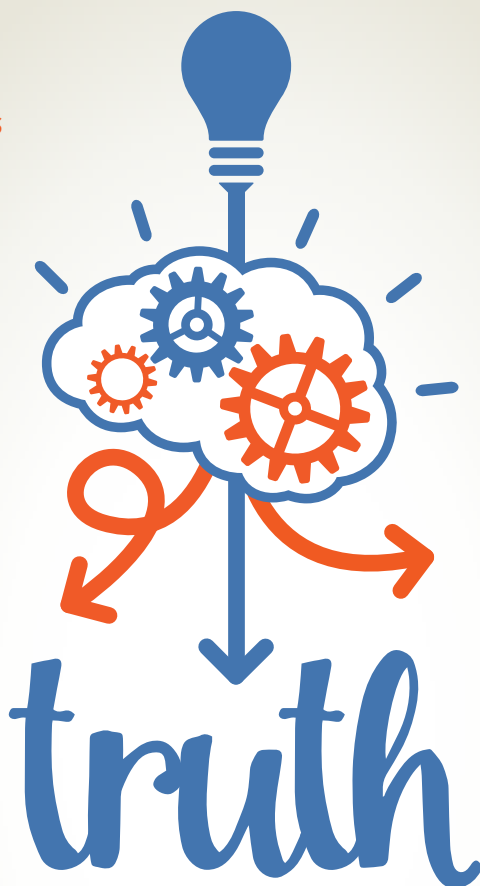
