


"Act wisely toward outsiders, making the most of the time. Your speech should always be gracious, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how you should answer each person."

– Col. 4:5-6 (HCSB)




ASK QUESTIONS!


1. "What do you mean by that?"
 - Gather more information
2. "How did you come to that conclusion?"
 - Causes others to think and keeps the burden of proof on them
3. "Have you ever considered...?"
 - You present your case for truth

- This message has **changed my life**, and here is how
- One or the other may need to be emphasized, depending on the audience
