The position is full time and will require other pastoral duties and responsibilities depending on additional giftings. A pastoral heart to shepherd people is a must.

We are looking for:

- A **man** with an authentic growing personal relationship with Jesus Christ. He is committed to Bible study, prayer, and personal sanctification.
- A **believer** who holds a passionate and firm understanding of the Gospel of Jesus Christ and is able to articulate that.
- A **husband/parent** (if applicable) who prioritizes the ministry of his wife and children.
- A **pastor/elder** who not only meets the biblical qualifications for leadership within the church (1 Timothy 3) but is growing in character, knowledge and skill. He has a shepherd's heart to use his spiritual gifts to comfort, counsel, convict, challenge and equip others (Eph. 4).
- A **student** of Scripture whose understanding of God's Word guides his decisions and leads the direction for family ministries.
- A **servant leader and teammate** who demonstrates humility as evidenced by the ability to listen and work with people with different backgrounds. He will lead the family ministry team with zeal and skill. He will work in partnership as part of the FFC elders.
- A **creative communicator** who demonstrates a bold, creative and missional spirit that desires to make God's glory known.

What he needs to have:

- A burden and a love for the growth and development of families - An understanding of building healthy marriages and developing Biblical parenting.
- A love for people - showing gentleness, and compassion.
- Two years of experience of leading family ministries.
- A desire and ability to work with volunteers with a variety of gifts and talents.
- References that can testify to his leadership ability and character.
- Technical skills to utilize technology for all aspects of family ministries and church life.

What he will do:

- Lead the church in the development of families from newborns to grandparents (great).
- Recruit, train and organize all volunteers for children's, youth and young adult services and activities.
- Pastor the ministry teams through development and spiritual growth while teaching a biblical philosophy of families.
- Oversee all areas of families ministry at FFC in coordination with the teaching pastor, elders and other church staff.
- Readily available to jump in wherever needed to further shepherd God's people.
- Join the membership of the church as an elder and be in agreement with our statement of faith.
- Participate with your family (if applicable) in aspects of church life.
- Participate in workshops and/or conferences in order to advance spiritual gifts and growth.
- Work together with church staff to coordinate all church activities through weekly staff meetings and give monthly ministry reports to the FFC elders.
