

## Ratio Christi Chapter Director Job Description

CDs are primarily responsible for building and overseeing an RC student organization on campus. Our ministry focuses on sharing and defending the faith. Directors work with student leaders to equip believers in apologetics and to evangelize the lost. We offer the flexibility of full or part-time time positions. Some CDs choose to operate as supported missionaries while others prefer to work on a volunteer basis.

### General Responsibilities:

1. Maintain a consistent and growing walk with Jesus Christ
2. Advance the mission, vision, doctrine, and values of Ratio Christi
3. Build and oversee an apologetics student organization at the campus
4. Build relationships with students, faculty, and staff at the campus
5. Train students to engage in evangelism through informal conversations and intentional outreach
6. Hold larger-scale outreach events as appropriate for the local campus (e.g. debates, seminars, etc.)
7. Minister to other student ministry organizations on campus through our specialization of apologetics and evangelism.
8. Shares the vision of Ratio Christi at various events when possible.

Proven interpersonal leadership and/or apologetics/ministry experience. Excellent interpersonal skills (written, verbal, interactive). Satisfactory ability to operate needed computer systems. Satisfactory ability to navigate social media platforms.
